

Website Acceptable Use Policy

This acceptable use policy sets out the terms between you and us under which you may use your website provided by Fat Media. This acceptable use policy applies to all users of, and visitors to, your website.

Your use of the website means that you accept, and agree to abide by, all the policies in this acceptable use policy.

Prohibited Uses of the Website

You may use your website only for lawful purposes.

You may not use your website:

- In any way that breaches any applicable local, national or international law or regulation.
- In any way that is unlawful or fraudulent, or has any unlawful or fraudulent purpose or effect.
- To transmit, or procure the sending of, any unsolicited or unauthorised email advertising or promotional material or any other form of similar solicitation (spam).
- To knowingly transmit any data, send or upload any material that contains viruses, Trojan horses, worms, time-bombs, keystroke loggers, spyware, adware or any other harmful programs or similar computer code designed to adversely affect the operation of any computer software or hardware.

You also agree:

Not to access without authority, interfere with, damage or disrupt:

- Any equipment or network on which our site is stored;
- Any software used in the provision of our site; or
- Any equipment or network or software owned or used by any third party.



Suspension and Termination

We will determine, in our discretion, whether there has been a breach of this acceptable use policy through your use of the website.

When a breach of this policy has occurred, we may take such action as we deem appropriate.

Failure to comply with this acceptable use policy constitutes a material breach of the terms of use upon which you are permitted to use the website, and may result in Fat Media taking all or any of the following actions:

- Immediate, temporary or permanent withdrawal of your right to use the website.
- Immediate, temporary or permanent removal of any illegal posting or material uploaded by you to the website.
- Issue of a warning to you.
- Disclosure of such information to any relevant law enforcement authorities as we reasonably feel is necessary.

We exclude liability for actions taken in response to breaches of this acceptable use policy. The responses described in this policy are not limited, and we may take any other action we reasonably deem appropriate.
